- Birth Certificate;
- Driver's license or state-issued identification card; or
- Social Security benefit statement showing age

## Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a senior discount on your Village of Ashville Refuse bill, you must meet the following requirements. Those approved will receive a 10% or \$1.50 discount on their charge, whichever is higher from their refuse charge.

- Be 62 years of age or older.
- Have an active Village of Ashville refuse account in your name (or your spouse's).
- To apply, please complete and return the application including proof of age.

## Other Information

If a customer becomes ineligible for the discount because they longer meet the requirements, the Village of Ashville must be notified as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days after the ineligibility.

Be aware that falsifying information or failing to notify a change in eligibility status may lead to:

- Recovery of past discounts
- Civil and/or criminal sanctions
