



ORDINANCE 2021-20

OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE



AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO JOIN CONSORTIUM III FOR THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ashville is concerned about health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Refuse services are contractually provided to Ashville; and

WHEREAS, Ashville has jurisdiction over items of this nature (Franchise for Solid Waste Disposal District) through Part Nine – Public Services, Chapter 953.02 and Ohio Revised Code 3734.01 et seq; and

WHEREAS, THE VILLAGE OF LOCKBOURNE in County has invited Ashville to join of Consortium III; and

WHEREAS, the joining of Consortium III would protect health and safety critically important to building, ecological, recreational, agricultural, heritage, public access, and other areas, the preservation of which would enhance the quality of life of the citizens of Ashville.

NOW, AND THEREAFTER BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE

Ashville council authorizes the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer to join Consortium III following a Letter of Invitation by the Village of Lockbourne, Exhibit A and executing agreements with Local Waste Services to provide residential and commercial refuse services to the Village of Ashville, incorporated by reference Exhibit C, see below Table.

Dear Mayor Wise:

I understand that the Village of Ashville desires to opt-in to SWACO's Community Consortium III and specifically, Lockbourne's contracts for collection (solid waste, recyclables, and yard waste) services with Local Waste and for recycling processing with Rumpke.

The contracts are attached and both were publicly bid and included the following language:

"This Joint Bid Process offers Bidders an opportunity to provide the Required Services, depending on the bids accepted by each of the Participating Communities, to an estimated 12,000 households in Grove City, 1,800 households in Jackson Township, 200 households in Urbancrest and 150 households in Lockbourne; and potentially additional Residential Units located in political subdivisions that may "opt in at a later date without the necessity of a future competitive bidding process, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code section 9.48".

If you and the Village so proceed, please provide to me a copy of the resolution, as I report all shared service arrangements to the Lockbourne Village Council.

Consortium Program

Since the inception of the Community Solid Waste and Recycling Consortium Program in 2005, in an effort to increase waste diversion, SWACO has been assisting communities with realizing greater value from their waste hauling contracts through a competitive, collaborative bidding process for curbside trash, recycling, and yard waste hauling services.

The Solid Waste Authority of Central Ohio (SWACO) jurisdiction is 41 communities in Franklin County, Ohio, which includes:

- 15 Cities
- 17 Townships
- 9 Villages



Community Services

The Consortium is voluntary and increases negotiating power when contracting for solid waste, recycling, and yard waste collection services; and allows consortium communities to provide curbside collection of single stream recyclables and yard waste pick-up to their residents, thus, reducing the amount of waste being landfilled. To assist in the development and implementation, SWACO contracts with a law firm that has a specialized background in solid waste and recycling.

Key Features

- Promotion of best management practices, including roll-cart recycling, volume-based disposal, data collection and analysis, resident participation surveys, and education and outreach initiatives.
- Cost-effective solid waste disposal contracting that requires commingled curbside recycling and yard waste diversion, with fees ranging from \$14 to \$15.53 per household per month
- Dissemination of educational materials
- Creates consistent policies and best practices throughout the District that allow us to make improvements and align with [SWACO Rules \(PDF\)](#)
- Enables SWACO to capture material diversion data through regular reporting via [Re-TRAC Connect](#)
- Promotes intergovernmental cooperation through the use of a unique and beneficial technical service

Results

- Created 3 community consortiums, which include 21 communities and encompass a total of 85,000 Franklin County households
- Successfully bid and awarded 49 municipal solid waste collection contracts
- The average recycling rate for a community within the consortium is 24%
- In 2015, Consortium communities diverted 22,700 tons of recyclables and 20,400 tons of yard waste; a total of 43,100 tons diverted from the landfill
