Regarding: West Station Street between Scioto and Lexington CDBG Project

On July 21, 2015 an agreement was executed for a repaving project on West Station Street between Lexington and Scioto Street. It is a \$54,000 project in which Pickaway County has gained approval for a Community Development Block Grant of \$49,617.34. The Contractor is Cox Paving, a Jurgensen Company. Work on this project has begun. The following is contact information:
