WHEREAS, the Village of Ashville and Earnhart Hill has been discussing the ability to provide water to one another through the construction of a connector between the two water systems.

NOW, AND THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council, Village of Ashville, Pickaway County, State of Ohio that:

SECTION ONE

The Mayor or Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for the engineering, design, PTI, and Construction of a water connector between the Village of Ashville and Earnhart Hill Regional Water District.

SECTION TWO

This Resolution is limited to \$25,000, beyond \$25,000 will require an additional authorization resolution.

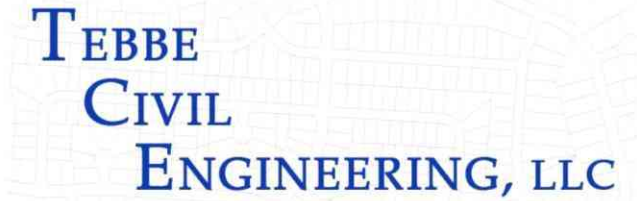

Dear Mr. Christman:

We are pleased to provide this proposal for survey and civil engineering services concerning the proposed Emergency Waterline Interconnection with Earnhart Hill Regional Water and Sewer District. The project is located along Lockbourne Eastern Road (Circleville Road) between South Bloomfield Royalton Road and East Main Street. We understand the project will generally involve the following:

- The Village of Ashville proposes to construct approximately 2,300' of water main to use as a temporary emergency connection due to the proposed demand in Ashville from new construction. This new water main will serve as a temporary connector until the Village is able to upgrade its' water systems.
- This proposal is based on the attached alignment plan exhibit.
- Survey will be performed by Power Geospatial, LTD. This will include project control, right-of-way and property line mapping, utility survey and topographic survey. This proposal includes six easement plats and legal descriptions for easements.
- We assume that the proposed water main will be installed outside of the right-of-way, therefore easements will be required. This alignment will require that some roadway crossings be installed using open-cut trench methods with trench pavement replacement only and does not include full-width street resurfacing.
- The Ohio EPA requires 10' of separation between water mains and parallel sanitary and storm sewers. We will attempt to maintain this separation for the design of this project. If existing sewer locations prevent the proposed water main from meeting this requirement, we will assist the Village in obtaining a waiver from the EPA for the section of water main. We will obtain an Ohio EPA Permit to Install (PTI) as part of the project.
- We assume the project will not require geotechnical or environmental services.



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- The design of the waterline will be according to the Village of Ashville, Earnhart Hill Regional Water & Sewer District and Ohio EPA design standards.

## SCOPE OF SERVICES

We propose to provide the following services:

### I. Task A - Survey

Survey services include project control, right-of-way and property line mapping, utility survey and topographic survey. This proposal includes six easement plats and legal descriptions for easements.

### II. Task B – Engineering Plans

We will prepare construction plans for the proposed waterline. The plans will include Title sheet, notes, quantities, details, plan and profile and maintenance of traffic. We will prepare a construction cost estimate for the project. This task also includes preparing and submitting the application for water PTI.

### III. Task C – Contract Documents and Bidding Services

We have included 56 hours of time for this task for site visits, meeting with Village staff to discuss alternatives, preparing the construction and bidding services. Any additional time authorized for these items or for construction-related services will be billed at our normal hourly rate per our attached Schedule of Hourly Costs.

### IV. Expenses (Included in Fees for Tasks A-C)

We have included up to \$660 in the above tasks for mileage and reproduction costs associated with the project.

## SCHEDULE OF FEES

We propose to provide consulting engineering services for this project on an estimated hourly fee basis according to our attached general terms and conditions with the following estimated maximum fees:

The Scope of Services and Schedule of Fees are based on certain assumptions and may be revised depending on the Village's requirements. Our fees will be invoiced monthly based on the services provided and payment is due upon receipt.
