



ORDINANCE 2021-03 OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE A PERSONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR BUILDING/PLANNING & ZONING SERVICES WITH WILLIAM R. TOOLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on January 2020, the Village of Ashville retained the Building Company of Toole & Associates and in particular, Certified Building Official (CBO) William R. Toole, to serve as its Building Inspector and Planning & Zoning Advisor; and

WHEREAS, the personal services contract for building inspection services expires; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Ashville understands and recognizes its need to retain an individual and company with a peculiar skill and aptitude to serve; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Ashville is pleased with the level of service and work being performed currently by its Inspector, and wants to continue this professional relationship; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Ashville now wants to retain again the services of William R. Toole to serve as Building Inspector and Planning & Zoning Advisor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION I

The Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement for Building Services, in substantially the same format and content, as the document attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, on behalf of the Village of Ashville.

SECTION II

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Ashville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION III

All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION IV

Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Village Council needs to approve and enter into this Agreement as soon as possible in order to continue providing the Village with uninterrupted services. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
