Thank you for your application in the Transportation Alternatives Program. Considerable time and effort were spent reviewing each application for its transportation need, costs, and benefits to the local community. The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is informing you that the Ashville Pedestrian Enhanced Intersection Improvement project has not been selected for funding in the Transportation Alternative Program.

However, the Safety Program has awarded this project **\$79,519.** Unlike the Transportation Alternatives funding, the Safety portion will be funded at 90% of the eligible costs in Federal funds. Also, the Safety funds need to be used in the Construction or Construction Engineering phases of the project in State Fiscal Year 2025.

It is very important to establish solid commitment dates for your project. Failure to meet the programmed sale date could result in funding being withdrawn.
