## AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1111.10 BUILDING FEES (IMPACT).



NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by Council of the Village of Ashville, Pickaway County, and State of Ohio:

**SECTION ONE:**

That the "Building Fee" listed under Chapter 1111.10 (a) – (c) be repealed. All building fees will be found under Part Thirteen.

**SECTION TWO:**

Strand Associates has completed an Impact Fee Report. Ashville Village Council passed Ordinance 2022-17 on December 19, 2022. This Ordinance will remove charges indicated in Section One. **23**

That this Ordinance will take effect after the earliest period allowed by law.

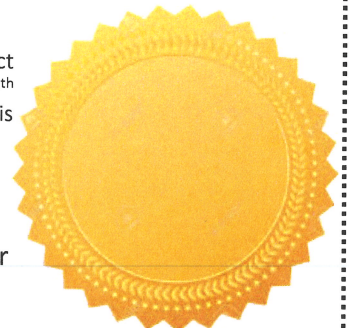
