Regarding: 2021 Park and Trail Grant Program Final Report

Dear Ms. Hartzler:

We greatly appreciate helping the Village of Ashville in the resurfacing of our park track. I have enclosed our Invoice that includes the Check to Roesse Bros. Paving Inc. for \$40,130 and their Invoice #3895 and 3896.

I have also put together a PowerPoint that will be presented at the July 12th Council Meeting. The PowerPoint will include the resurfacing of the track in 2021 and the investment in 2020 and 2019 for replacing picnic tables and benches. The total expenditure is \$70,515 of which the Pickaway County Park District provided \$17,313 or about \$25%. The slides display the use of the track, benches, and picnic tables for the July 4th Celebration. They will also be used well by Fun-in-the-Sun, the Viking Festival, Gazebo Gatherings, Cook-outs, Baseball Teams, and other park activities.
