Now that we have funding opportunities through impact fees, Exhibit G, we need a plan. The current parks and recreational facilities will not be adequate for the future needs of the community, see Exhibit A. It will need to convert its current parks area to local community park and look toward the development of a new location that can handle a community that will be approaching 10,000 residents.</p>

What amenities do you feel you community would like to see at this park?:</p> <p>*If you need more space please attach pages</p>	<p>In 2022, the Village of Ashville contracted with Strand Associates to complete an Impact Fee Study. The intent of this study was to determine the future needs of the Village for Streets, Police, Fire, Government, and Parks & Recreation. Exhibit E includes parts of the Strand Associates Report with a focus on Section 3 Development of Parks and Recreation Impact Fee. The report indicates a current park system of 10.6 acres and a future need of an additional 86.18 acres. Therefore, the Village is looking at finding 100 or more acres of land to a acquire and develop. It would be desirable that this area is connected to existing parks with a plan to connect to South Bloomfield, Harrison Township, Pickaway County, and the trail system the is the focus of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) as part of Central Ohio Greenways and RAPID 5, see Exhibit F.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">    </div>
