Project Title:	2019 Pickaway County Park District/Ashville Picnic Tables and Benches Replacement Project.

Describe IN DETAIL Proposed Project:	The Village of Ashville is proposing to replace ten (10) picnic tables, Exhibit B, in the Open Shelter House, Exhibit A. The other square picnic table and two (2) benches, Exhibit B, would be placed in the north west playground area, Exhibit A.
	There are two purposes for this Equipment Project Request. First, the replacement will increase the safety of people using the tables in the Open Shelter House. The reason involves the decades of use and deteriorating condition, Exhibit D. The original design of the current tables pose a safety risk. The center of balance makes them vulnerable to tipping. The edges of the tables are worn with many "End Caps" no longer on the tables. These areas could result in a laceration if not covered, Exhibit D. The Village has continued to try to keep them in repair but the time has been reached to replace with tables that meet the safety standards of today.

The open shelter house is used for Fun in the Sun a summer education program, the July 4th Celebration, Viking Festival, and other public activities, Figure 3. The other picnic table and 2 benches will be placed in the play ground area. The ADA fountain will be place just west of the shelter house for general park use.

List other sources of income for the organization or project including amounts:

The Village of Ashville will commit \$2,001.30 from it's Park Budget 1000-320-690-0000 to complete the balance of the cost, see attached Appropriation Budget Figure 1.

What will be the impact on the organization, project or activity if this application is not funded?

The Village of Ashville will continue to use the current tables and benches. The enclosed photos show that they have become dangerous because of years of use and missing parts such as end caps. The balance of the tables makes them prone to tip, Figure 4.

How will you evaluate the success or effectiveness of your project or activity?

The tables being used for the events within the Ashville Park. Tables that will not tip. The reduction of risk of individual being cut from the metal of the tables. The new tables are coated, Figure 1.

What other information do you believe is important for us to consider?

This area is used by a significant number of Ashville residents and guests. We can acknowledge your foundation funds with a plaque, Figure 5. This recognizes you and will encourage others to donate funds to Ashville.


