ORDINANCE(S) FOR THIRD READING

2019-01 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2003-11 LONGEVITY PAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Brad Lutz moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to have the Third Reading. All votes were yea. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by Brad Lutz, to approve the Third Reading and adopt as an emergency measure. All votes were yea.

ORDINANCE(S) FOR SECOND READING

2019-02 AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR'S EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, BASED UPON THE AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF RESOURCES ISSUED BY THE PICKAWAY COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Brad Lutz moved, seconded by Randy Loveless, to have the Second Reading. All votes were yea. After the reading, Nelson Embrey moved, seconded by David Rainey, to approve the Second Reading. All votes were yea.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Brad Lutz noted that he was disappointed in the legislature's response to the gasoline tax increase and their lack of support for the proposed tax.
