The Mayor's Column-Recycling/Refuse Update

There is a lot of data in the two tables below. They compare recycling and refuse from 2015 through 2019. You see monthly averages, means, and yearly totals. Two important numbers can be seen involving 2019. First, recycling increased 19.5% over 2018. Second, refuse actually decreased for the first time. To be precise, refuse dropped by 202 tons or just over 10% drop from 2018. With an increasing population, Ashville has increased recycling decrease landfill refuse.


