This letter forms a part of and modifies the original SOQ Documents issued for the above referenced project.

Question #1:

Can you please send a link for the OEPA report as well as the referenced preliminary engineering report listed in the public notice?

Response:

Please ignore this item. It was a carry-over requirement from the Water Treatment Facility SOQ.

Question #2:

Can you elaborate more on the EPA pre-qualification requirement listed?

Response:

There is no specific EPA pre-qualification needed for this project. However, the proposed design team must demonstrate experience on similar projects in the State of Ohio and previous coordination and experience with the OEPA.

Question #3:

Is there a max page limit for the RFQ? - or page limit per section? Defined list of sections that should be included in proposal?

Response:

The proposal shall be limited to a maximum of thirty (30) 8 ½" x 11" single sided pages (may be printed double sided). Cover and divider pages are excluded from the page count.

Question #4:

Is there an existing developer agreement that the WRRF needs to have available capacity by a certain date to account for future growth?

Response:

The expansion of the plant must be accomplished as soon as practical. Specific development needs will be discussed with the short-listed companies.

Question #5:

Is there existing Ohio EPA documentation or reports for the WRRF expansion?

Response:

The Village is currently expanding their water plant and the Ohio EPA has asked that capacity of the WRRF be increased to match or exceed the water plant capacity. Proposed commercial and residential projects are also a significant factor in the sizing of the WRRF.

Question #6:

Is there a specific timeline that the WRRF expansion needs to be placed into service by? This is to assist us with developing project schedules for planning, design, bidding, and construction.

Response:

The expansion of the plant must be accomplished as soon as practical. Specific development needs will be discussed with the short-listed companies.

Question #7:

The Qualifications Evaluation Criteria page does not have weighted scoring criteria for each item. Can this be provided?

Response:
